- **World Suicide Prevention Day** – Sept 10.

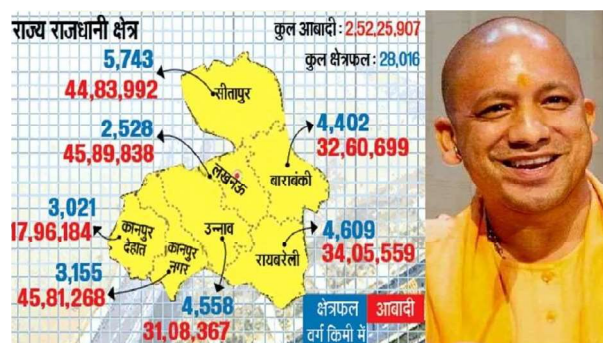
Theme (triennial) for 2021-2023 – ‘Creating Hope through Action’.

- Which state recently started Bagless School one day in a week? – Madhya Pradesh.

As per the **National Education Policy and School Policy 2020** of the state, MP government has come up with this policy.

- Which state has decided to develop ‘State Capital Region (SCR)’ like Delhi-NCR i.e. National Capital Region? – Uttar Pradesh (This will be developed in Lucknow)



Districts that will be included in this SCR – Sitapur, Rae Bareli, Kanpur Nagar, Barabanki, Kanpur Dehat and Unnao.

- First indigenous aircraft carrier of India, INS Vikrant was recently commissioned by – PM Narendra Modi, at- Cochin Shipyard, Kochi, Kerala.



- The global startup challenge started by Karnataka government – VentuRISE. This will help entrepreneurs in manufacturing industries and sustainable industries.

- **NEP 2020 (National Education Policy 2020)** compliant 1st Law School in India – IILM University - The university recently received the approval of Uttar Pradesh Government and recognition of BCI (Bar Council of India).

- Newly appointed Executive Chairman of NALSA (National Legal Services Authority) – **D Y Chandrachud** (Famous Justice of India)

- **India's first green truck** fuelled by LNG launched recently by – Blue Energy Motors. The truck was unveiled in – Chakan, Pune.

- India's first '**Dark Sky Reserve**' is going to be set up in – Henley, Ladakh. This is being constructed to accelerate the Astro-Tourism in Ladakh.

Total no. of districts (as of now) in Chhattisgarh – 31.

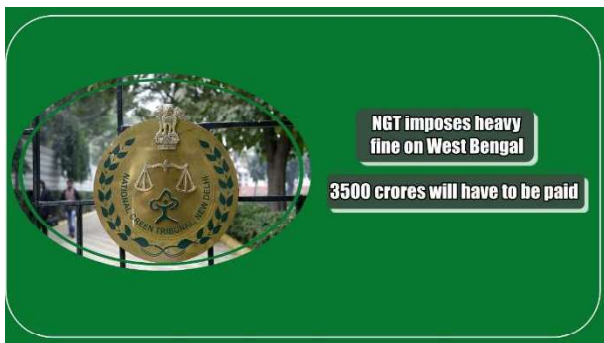
- New **CEO of Sansad TV – Utpal Kumar Singh**. This is his additional duty beside his post of the Secretary General of the Lok Sabha.

State (Daspara village). It will have the livelihood and lifestyle based on nature. The use of chemical fertilizers will be curtailed.

- First village in the state of Uttar Pradesh to possess **RO water system in each and every household – Bhartaul village**, Bareilly District. This has been executed under- Adarsh Gram Panchayat initiative. This will avail clean drinking water to everyone and will reduce the risk of water-borne disease.

- The **first intranasal COVID-19 vaccine** (free of needle) of India has been originated by which company – **Bharat Biotech**. DCGI recently gave consent the intranasal vaccine for emergency usage in 18+ adults only.

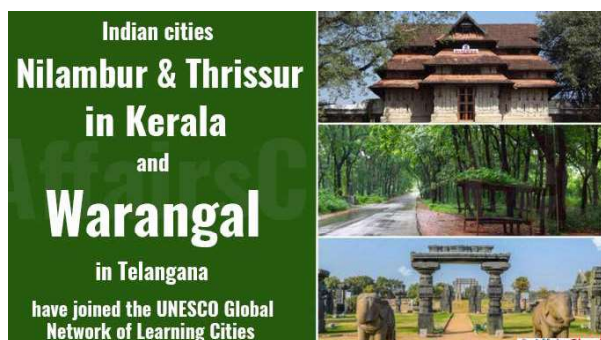
- **“Pudhumai Penn”** scheme for ensuring the support for women in the higher education sector has been launched by – Tamil Nadu. The scheme was launched by CM MK Stalin at Bharathi College for women. The meaning of the term “Pudhumai Penn” – ‘Modern woman’.

- Which state government recently distributed 869 crore Rupees for state farmers (41 lakh farmers and 85k landless farmers) under KALIA

**(Krushak Assistance for Livelihood and Income Augmentation)** scheme – Odisha. A DBT of 2000 was made to each ones' bank account.

- Multiplex Association of India (MAI) has announced to celebrate the **National Cinema Day** on – Sept 16 throughout the country. This event will be observed across 4000 screens all over India.

- Which cities from India has made their place in the **UNESCO Global Network of Learning Cities (GNLC) – Warangal** (Telangana) & Thrissur and Nilambur (Kerala). A total of 77 cities have recently been listed from 44 countries all over the world in the list. The list contains 294 cities all over the world.



- As per a recent report released by NITI Aayog on Poshan Abhiyan Scheme (title – “**Preserving Progress on Nutrition in India: Poshan Abhiyan in Pandemic Times**”), the state that has secured the 1st rank in implementation of the scheme – Maharashtra; 2nd- Andhra Pradesh; 3rd- Gujarat.

Best performance among small states – Sikkim.

- Which Indian state recently launched the ‘**Indira Gandhi Shehari**

**Rojgar Guarantee’** scheme? – Rajasthan.

It is India’s all time 1st employment guarantee scheme for the poor community of the urban areas. This scheme will provide 100 days guaranteed employment to urban poor people, specially who lost jobs during the period of Covid-19 pandemic.

- New **Chief Justice of Madras High Court – M Duraiswamy**. He was appointed recently by Hon’ble President Draupadi Murmu.

Duraiswamy will take the charge from Justice M. N. Bhandari who had assumed the charge as an acting chief justice from Nov’21.

- Which state recently topped the state ranking in the proper usage of e-prosecution portal under the Union Govt’s ‘**Digital India Mission**’ – UP.

2nd- MP, 3rd – Bihar

The state that has secured the first rank in this portal regarding the disposal of online cases – UP.

- ‘**International Tourism Award 2023**’ award for ‘Best Destination for Culture’ received by which state of India – West Bengal. The award was given by – PATWA (Pacific Area Travel Writers Association). PATWA is an affiliated member of UNWTO (UN World Tourism Organisation).

The award was presented at ‘World Tourism and Aviation Leaders’ Summit which took place in – Berlin, Germany.

In this ceremony, which country was selected as Caribbean’s Leading

Cultural Destination for the year 2022 – Cuba.

- FSSAI (Food Safety & Standards Authority of India) recently awarded the **5-star 'Eat Right Certificate' rating to which Central Jail – Fatehgarh Central Jail, Farrukhabad district, Uttar Pradesh.** The jail provides a very high quality and hygienic food to the inmates.
- The **Unit 1 of the Maitree Super Thermal Power Project inaugurated** recently by – **Indian PM N. Modi** and Bangladesh PM S. Hasina jointly. This project is being constructed under the Concessional financing scheme of India.
- Recently, which 2 countries jointly collaborated to design and conduct a **cyber security exercise in 26 countries – India & UK.**



It was a Joint venture of – BAE systems (British Aerospace) + NSCS (National Security Council Secretariat ) of India + UK Government.

- MoEFCC (Ministry of Forest, Environment & Climate Change) approved recently the **New Coastal Zone Management Plan** according to

new CRZ (Coastal Regulation Zone) notification for which state? – Karnataka. It is the first southern state and only the second state in India to get this plan.

- Recently, for controlling the pollution during upcoming festive season, which state/UT declared a complete **ban on the production, selling and usage of firecrackers upto 1st Jan'2023 – Delhi;** announced by Delhi environment minister Gopal Rai.
- **India's' longest rubber dam named the 'Gayaji Dam'** was unveiled in – Bihar on – Falgu river of Gaya district by CM – Nitish Kumar. The dam is 411 meters long with a height of 3 meters.



- **'Ni-kshay 2.0 portal'** launched recently by – Hon'ble President of India, Draupadi Murmu. It has been launched to provide support to the patients suffering from Tuberculosis. TB.

This portal has been launched under the TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyan. MHFW (Ministry of Health and Family Welfare) has set the target of eradicating TB from India by 2025.

- **CHHATA (Community Harnessing and Harvesting Rain water** Artificially from Terrace to

Aquifer) scheme to improve rainwater harvesting in the state has been launched by which government – Odisha.

- **A white horse named ‘Tejas’** has been gifted to Indian defence minister Shri Rajnath Singh by which country – Mongolia. The gift was given by President of Mongolia - U. Khurelsukh.

- Union Minister of Road, Transport and Highways (MoRTH minister), Shri Nitin Gadkari has inaugurated a conference regarding the issues related to road, transport & logistics sector. The conference is named – **‘Manthan’**. It is being held in – Bengaluru.



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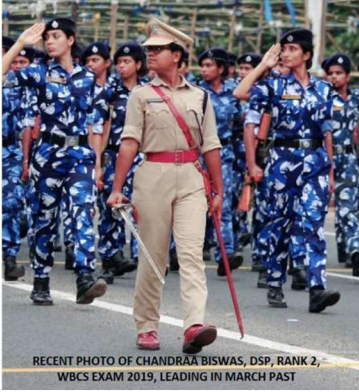

### PAPER 1

1. Why is attention selective in nature? Explain with the help of suitable theoretical perspectives. Also discuss the different determinants of attention with suitable examples.

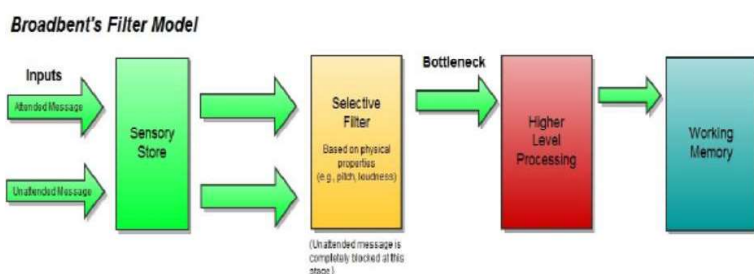
Ans: Selective attention is the process of focusing on a particular object and directing our awareness to relevant stimuli while ignoring irrelevant stimuli in the environment.

Attention being a limited resource there is a limit to how much information can be processed at a given time, and it is because of selective in nature, attention allows us to tune out insignificant details and focus on what is important.

Theories of Selective Attention -

1. Broadbent's Filter Theory- Broadbent proposed that physical characteristics of messages are used to select one message for further processing and rest all others are lost.

### Broadbent filter theory

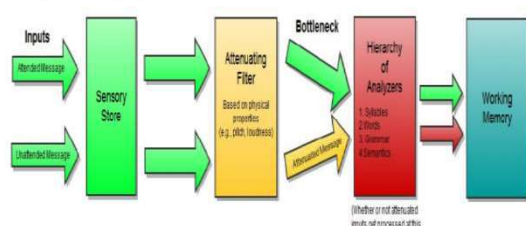


Information from various stimuli presented at any given time enters the sensory buffer. One of the inputs is then selected based on its physical characteristics to pass through a filter. He

assumed that the filter rejected the unattended message at an early stage of processing.

2. Treisman's Attenuation Theory - Treisman proposed that instead of a filter, attention works by utilizing an attenuator that identifies a stimulus based on physical properties or by meaning.

### Treisman's attenuation model



Only difference with the earlier one is that Treisman's filter attenuates rather than eliminating the unattended material.

Determinants of Attention are of two types -

1. External factors
2. Internal factors

External Factors are generally those characteristics of outside situation or stimuli which captures our attention.

1. Nature of the stimulus: Pictures of human beings invite more attention than others.
2. Intensity and size of the stimulus: Our attention become easily directed towards a loud sound, a bright light.
3. Contrast, change and variety: we do not notice the ticking sound of a clock put on the wall until it stops ticking. That is any change immediately capture our attention.
4. Repetition of stimulus: While giving lecture the important aspects of the speech are often repeated so that the attention of the audience can be easily directed to the valuable points.
5. Movement of the stimulus: Advertisers make use of this fact and try to catch the attention of people through moving electric lights.

Internal Factors: These are subjective factors which influences individual's attention.

Interest: In any get-together if any subject of our interest is discussed, it attracts our attention easily. We attend to objects in which we have interest.

Similarly, our mindset, attitudes, moods, needs or motives equally govern our attention for specific events or objects. Moreover, the mental readiness of a person to respond to certain stimuli or preparedness also determines the attention level for that person.

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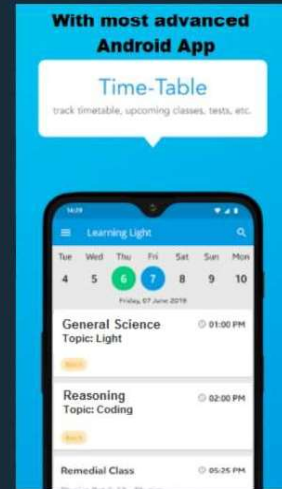
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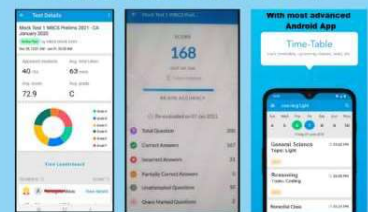
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
